# Board Representation

- WATS and County Economic Development Department efforts
  - In 2009, reviewed 7 options for 13 or 14 board members
  - Considered both population and charter millage
  - All kept the 7 City of Ann Arbor members
  - All had to be elected

# Board Representation

- WATS and Washtenaw County Economic Development Department
  - In 2011, started over with 15 member board
  - Appointed options only reviewed
  - New Ypsilanti City millage
  - Used population and charter millages
  - Assumed that charter millages in addition to new funding
