

## Ann Arbor, MI Survey Results

**Q1** Generally speaking do you think things in Ann Arbor are headed in the right direction, or do you think they're off on the wrong track?

*Think things in Ann Arbor are headed in the right direction* ..... 41%  
*Think things in Ann Arbor are off on the wrong track* ..... 41%  
*Not sure* ..... 18%

**Q2** Last fall Washtenaw County voters approved a ballot proposal called the Washtenaw County Community Mental Health and Public Safety Preservation Millage. When this millage was passed, was it your expectation that the funds raised from it would be used for mental health and public safety services?

*Yes* ..... 77%  
*No* ..... 11%  
*Not sure* ..... 12%

**Q3** A majority of the members of the Ann Arbor City Council have indicated their intention is to spend 40 percent of Ann Arbor's total millage allocation, equal to of \$8 million dollars over 8 years, on action to fight climate change. At the time of the vote on the Community Mental Health and Public Safety Preservation Millage, how aware were you of the City Council's plan to spend money from the millage on action to fight climate change- were you very much aware, somewhat aware, only vaguely aware, or not aware at all?

*Very much aware* ..... 12%
